Half the team left directly after the mission for home, whereas the other half spent two days in Livingstone before returning.*



### ONE WAY PRE SCHOOLS

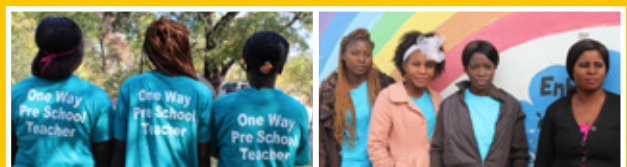


All the children were issued with a new school uniform that consisted of a T-Shirt, jersey, beanie and shorts or skirts. Maureen and her team of helpers made 160 shorts/skirts before departing for Zambia. We are blessed and thankful for their commitment. This is the first time that Kabula One School received shorts or skirts. The children are all receiving a meal each school day. We were blessed to have Ethel, who is a nurse, as part of the team. She examined all the children and treated mild conditions that she found among the children.



### SANKANDI PRE SCHOOL

Sankandi School is going well under the leadership of teacher Grace. They have 54 children, two teachers, two assistants, a cook and security.





The children are progressing well and are well behaved and attentive to their teachers. The school treated us to a fun day that was enjoyed by the children, the mothers, the teachers and the team.



### KABULA ONE PRE SCHOOL

Kabula One Pre School never ceases to amaze us and we give God all the glory for this. They have 92 children, three teachers and a cook.



The children are happy and always pleased to see us. The teachers are managing well under difficult conditions as they have three mud walled classrooms and no assistants. The change in these children is a joy to see. They also treated us to a fun day where we enjoyed their traditional dancing and singing and their recital of Bible verses.



Lisa, a teacher from Emmanuel Private School spent time connecting with the teachers and training them. Our team helped with the classes while the teachers were being trained. We are very happy with the progress of both schools.

### VILLAGE MINISTRY

José and his team went out to the villages each day where they spread the gospel, prayed for people and helped with basic first aid. A number of people gave their lives to Christ through this ministry and there were reports of people being healed after prayer.



### LADIES PRACTICAL

Maureen once again worked with the ladies of Sankandi, and for the first time also helped the mothers of Kabula One to complete their children's skirts/shorts.

### CAMPFIRES

We held two campfire outreaches, one in Kabula One and one in Sankandi. Many people were prayed for after the campfires and there were reports of healings as well as people asking to receive Christ.



We trust that the kindling that we leave each year as we visit Zambia will spread into a revival in the area. Our aim is to win this part of Zambia for Christ.
